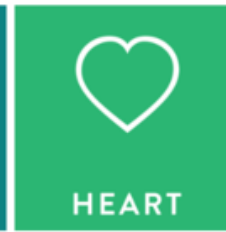

## How to Enroll in Calloway 4-H

Go to [www.4honline.com](http://www.4honline.com)

### NEW MEMBERS

1. Click "Don't have an account?"
2. Follow the prompts to create a new 4H Online account.
3. Make the name of your family your last name.
4. Add members to your family (members are the youth you are enrolling in 4-H). **Do not add parents as members.**
5. Click "Enroll" under each child's name. Follow the prompts.
6. Choose "Calloway 4-H" as your club and "Exploring 4-H" as your project. **Do not select any other clubs or projects for now!**
7. Continue following the prompts to complete your 4-H enrollment. Make sure to click "submit" at the end.

### RETURNING MEMBERS

1. Fill in your email that is on file with the Extension Office and then click "reset password". **All returning members will have to reset their password.** Call the office at 270-753-1452 if you do not know what email is on file. **DO NOT start a new account with a different email.**
2. Open the email sent to your inbox and follow the instructions to reset your password.
3. Click "Enroll" under your child's name. Continue with instructions #4-7 under the New Members box to the left on this page.

### RETURNING BUT I DONT HAVE ACCESS TO THE EMAIL I HAVE ON FILE WITH THE EXTENSION OFFICE

1. Contact the Calloway Extension Office to add/change your email to your youth's account. **DO NOT start a new account with a different email.**
2. Open the email sent to your inbox and follow the instructions to reset your password.
3. Click "Enroll" under your child's name. Continue with instructions #4-7 under the New Members box to the left on this page.
